Samar Shaikh, BDS, MS is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry. Currently, she serves as an Assistant Professor at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine in Boston, MA, while also holding a part-time associate position at a private practice in Portland, Maine. Dr. Shaikh was honored with the 2021 American Academy of Periodontology Foundation Educator Award for excellence in teaching and mentoring in periodontics. She is a contributing author to the textbook "Clinical Cases in Periodontics" and the electronic edition of "Carranza's Clinical Periodontology".

Shayan Barootchi, DMD, MS is an Adjunct Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of Michigan, Department of Periodontics and Oral Medicine. Dr. Barootchi has published over 90 peer-reviewed scientific articles and his work has been the recipient of national and international prestigious awards. Currently, Dr. Barootchi's clinical research focuses on microsurgical and minimally-invasive approaches for soft tissue augmentation around teeth, dental implants, and at the time of immediate implant therapy.

Lorenzo Tavelli, DDS, MS is full-time assistant professor at the Department of Oral Medicine, Infection, and Immunity, Division of Periodontology at the Harvard School of Dental Medicine, Boston, and a diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology. Dr. Tavelli has published more than 100 scholarly publications in the main international peer-reviewed journals while serving as associate editor for Clinical Implant Dentistry and Related Research and as a reviewer for journals in periodontics and implant dentistry.
